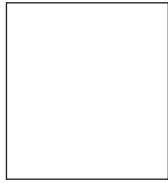

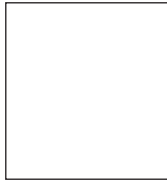

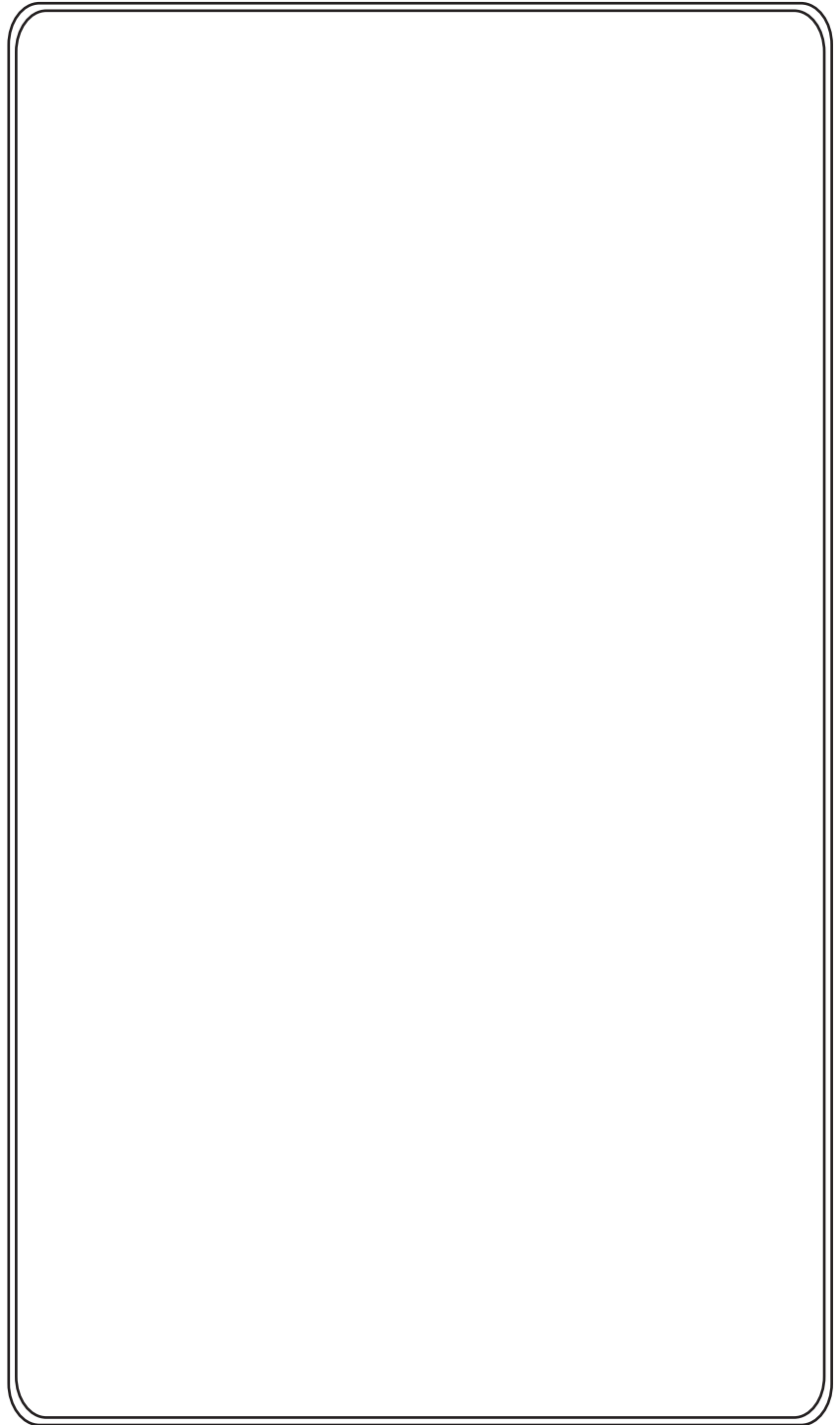

ADMISSION:-

Admission is open to children:-

1. Who have completed 2 ½ years of age and below 3 ½ years as on 1st July of the session, in Nursery and
2. Who have completed 3 ½ years of age as on 1st July of the session, in pre-primary class.

In the first instance children will be admitted to Nursery and pre-primary only. The Pre-primary course is of two years duration. Ordinarily, no child will be admitted to the School unless he/she starts from PP-1. For admission to other classes Transfer Certificate is compulsory.

For admission to Nursery to PP-II date of birth certificate is must. For admission from class-I onwards T.C. (original) & Marksheet of the previous class & adhar card is must.

Note: Admission Open on all working days From 8.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1 PAYMENT OF FEES:

- 1) Fee must be paid in advance before the last working day of every month.
- 2) For late payment a fine of Rs 1 per day will be charged till the next month thereafter Rs 10 per month.
- 3) Finally /Thereafter, the name of student will be struck off from the rolls of the school.
- 4) If the name is struck off once, the student may be readmitted within 15 days by clearing all dues and paying a readmission fee.
- 5) If the dues are not cleared before the due date, the student will not be allowed to appear for the ensuing extinction and in such case no re-examination will be conducted. Management in its absolute discretion may allow concession in fees in deserving cases.
- 6) The maintenance fee is charged only for 10 months.

2) ATTENDANCE:

Every student must attend the school. at least 85% of the total working days, Students who fail to maintain the above percentage will not be allowed to appear in the Annual Promotion examination.

3) LEAVE:

1. Leave may be granted in case of extreme emergency only on special request from the parent/guardian, in the leave record column provided in the diary itself.
2. Separate application sent for this purpose will not be considered.

3. Ordinarily such leave shall be limited to maximum of three days only. Medical leave extending up to maximum 10 days shall be granted to a student on producing the medical certificate. Those who nail from other states will not get more than 15 days leave to go to their native place.

4) ABSENCE:

Unauthorized absence from the school shall be considered as serious misconduct and strong disciplinary action shall be taken against the defaulter rolls.

5) WITHDRAWAL:

Student can be withdrawn from the school at any time. A Notice of withdrawal must reach the office at least 10 days in advance on clearing all the dues of the school, school leaving certificat will be issued.

Admissions are made on full year basis and the parent/guardian is required to pay charges for the full year.

No remission in charges will be allowed on any account.

6) EXPULSION:

A student may be expelled from the school for any of the following reasons.

1. Misconduct & Indiscipline.
2. Unsatisfactory academic performance.
3. Failing twice the same class

4. Non-payment of school dues.
5. Violating school rules.

N.B. If a student is expelled from the school, dues up to the month of expulsion will be charged.

7. PUNCTUALITY:

Those who come late i.e. after the 1st bell, will not be allowed to go to class and they will be sent back unless concerned parents personally call to the head of the instiution and adduce satisfactory reason for the student reaching the school late, They will be marked absent and are liable for punishment as mentioned in the absent clause of this diary.

8. MEDIUM OF CONVERSATION: Eighsr

Students of Standard III on wards should use English only as the medium of conversation in the school premises dissur? Using any language other than English will result in the deduction of marks of the house in which he/she belong to and a fine of Rs. 1.00 will be charged. These fines will not be collected every day it will be noted in the diary in the column provided for it then and there and total of fine of one month will be collected before the 5th of next month. (see column provided for this) not repined

9. CODE OF CONDUCT

- * All students are expected to attend school neatly dressed and in hygienic way.
- * Every student should obey the teacher's instruction as also other officials of the school.
- * Students are expected to keep their class-rooms and surroundings clean.

- * Mishandling of school properties will be penalised on a/c of material reigned from the student.
- * Strict disciplinary action will be taken against objectional acts/admissions.

10. ASSEMBLY

- * Students in proper uniform should stand in line according to their heights and pay devotion and concentration during assembly.
- * Every student is expected to participate in House Activities.

11. RELE/ DUTIE OF CAPTAIN

- * House captains to fulfill all the responsibilities diligently. They must show high order of discipline in every event and other school activities.
- * No abusive language or use of slang words inside the class room or school premises is permitted.
- * House prefects and captains have to fulfill all the responsibilities diligently. They must show high order of discipline in every event and other school activities.
- * Co-curricular activities and participation in school festivals are compulsory being the part of curriculum of one's education.

TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS:

In order to secure all that is best in the education of your child the maximum co-operation between parents and school authorities is desirable. Parents/guardians should check the child's school manual every day and see that the lessons and home work assigned for

the next day are done. complete Parent should be encouraged to cultivate the habit of neatness in their word uniform hdisciphie.

As your children advance in age, guide them to become resourceful and useful members of both home and country Encourage self help in work and study. The formation of good work habits early in life inculcates in children the idea of dignity of work, a fundamental personal virtue for successful career in life.

1. Parents and guardians must help the school authorities in moulding the character of their children. They are therefore, most earnestly requested to see:
 - a) That the rules of the school are carefully observed by their children.
 - b) That their children come to school regularly and neatly dressed.
 - c) That they insist their children devoting to study at least 2 hours daily.
2. That they examine the monthly record of attendance, conduct and application and any other remarks in their children's school manual.
3. The school accepts no responsibility of a student is obliged to return home during school hour for failure to comply with school regulations dease.
4. A student found guilty of breaking school regulations or committing any act of indiscipline is liable to be punished at the discretion of the Principal.
5. The engagement of private tutors, whether of the school staff or otherwise is not recommended as it is injurious to proper study.

Failure of parents to cooperate with the school authorities in the education and discipline of their children in school may necessitate the removal of the child from school.

EXAMINATION:

Exams. will be conducted strictly as per model laid by Education department. There will be 2 Summative Assessments and 4 Formative Assessments for Nur - VIII. Quarterly,

Unit test(excluding quarterly, Half discussion yearly and Final Examination) will be held from the 20th of the month. If 20th happens to be holiday the test will start on the next working day, (IX-XII)

PROGRESS REPORT AND ANSWER PAPER:

All papers of examination except those of selection and annual Promotion examination will be sent to the Parents/guardians between 5th and 10th days of every month and they should send them back on the next day itself after their counter signature. Parents/Guardians are also requested to scrutinize the answer book of their ward carefully and to take all measures to improve his/her standard. Any alteration done of the answer paper with regard to marks or answers by the students or parents will be viewed serious and punishment for such unauthorized alteration will extend up to removal of the student from the institution.

VISITING OF PARENTS/GUARDIANS:

The Head of the Institution will be glad to meet the Parents guardians to discuss with them the progress of their children. There will be a parents-teachers meeting on last Saturday of every month.

The name and relationship of the guardians with respect to each student should be intimated to the school authorities in the beginning of the year so that the said guardians could be entertained for discussions with the head of the Institution.

The management will try to convene meeting of the parents/guardians in the second quarter of the session to invite suggestion for improvement.

The Institution will be open for inspection by education and other concerned authorities.

MEDICAL CHECK UP:

Each student will undergo Medical checkup once in a year.

DISCIPLINE:

Students must:

- * Come to school neat and clean in proper uniform and shoes well polished.
- * Be regular in attendance.
- * Never be late to school.
- * Attend morning assembly without fail.
- * Have sportsman spirit at all times, be fair and honest at work and always be considerate of the rights of others.
- * Be courteous and respectful to parents, teachers and visitors.
- * Look after and protect the property of school, keep it clean and tidy.
- * Keep the class room neat and throw waste papers, wrappers etc. in the waste paper basket only.

- * Reach the class rooms as soon as the warning bell goes or recess is over.
- * Produce application duly signed by the parent if he/she happened to go ½ day.

Students must not:

- * Bring valuable articles such as rings or other ornaments, mobile, cash to the school. School will not be responsible for the loss of such articles.
- * Lend or borrow money or any article.
- * Shout or make noise in the school or create confusion in the auditorium or class room.
- * Leave bicycles unlocked or ride in the school compound.
